CCP12 - The Global Association of Central Counterparties has the pleasure to take part in the Shanghai Symposium on OTC-Derivatives.

Jointly sponsored by People's Bank of China (PBC) and the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago (FRBC), the Symposium on OTC Derivatives is the premier symposium in Asia to promote policy development and explore industry best practice for the derivatives market. Senior officials from international regulators, industry leaders, and experts from academia will be brought together annually to exchange views on critical issues.

The 1st symposium held in 2017 focused on risk management and regulatory issues at central counterparties (CCPs). Mr. PAN Gongsheng, Deputy Governor of PBC, Mr. Charles Evans, President and Chief Executive Officer of FRBC, and Ms. Daniela Russo, Co-chair of CPMI-IOSCO Policy Standing Group presented keynote speeches.

The 2nd annual symposium, building on the fruitful results of last year, will focus on regulatory concerns currently facing the central clearing industry. This symposium will feature keynote speeches and panel discussions with experts from international and national regulatory authorities including PBC and FRBC, international industry organizations, major CCPs and key market participants. Topics covered will include the evolution of the independent clearing house, default management auctions and central clearing interdependencies. The 2nd Annual Symposium will be held in Shanghai on June 26th, 2018.
